NFS	At least 50% in Sec 2 FCE		
ESS (O level)	To offer Exercise and Sports Science:		
	(i) At least <u>B grade for 2.4km run</u> , or to represent the school in a <u>competitive sport</u> (excluding bowling)		
	(ii) 60% in Science		
	(iii) 50% in English Language

- 1) Your results (Overall percentage)
- 2) Your choices based on the online survey in Semester 2
- 3) Prerequisites for taking the various subjects
- 4) Number of places available (Minimum enrolment to open a class for a specific subject: <u>10</u> students)

- Selection is on <u>SLS</u>
- Selection of Subject Combination is by codes.
  - 1. Refer to the printed <u>code list</u> (To be given before the selection process).
  - Each student is allowed to select <u>5 choices</u>.
  - 3. Rank the choices according to your preference. Ensure you are eligible for the combination you have chosen.
  - 4. Key in the <u>5 codes</u> into SLS.
