- To fine-tune subject combination offering in October based on students' interest and availability of school resources.

# PREDOMINANTLY G1 SUBJECTS



## Important things to note

- Students taking predominantly G1 subjects in Secondary 2 will take 6 subjects when they progress to Secondary 3.

*Note: Students who are officially exempted from Mother Tongue may take 5 subjects.*

- Students will rank their choices of the 6<sup>th</sup> subject using the ALL EARS platform (where 1<sup>st</sup> choice is the most preferred and 5<sup>th</sup> choice is the least).
- Being eligible for a combination does not guarantee that you will get the combination. It is also dependent on your choice and the vacancies in each subject combination.

# PREDOMINANTLY G1 SUBJECTS



## Important things to note

- Students taking predominantly G1 subjects in Secondary 2 will select from **Combination A** (for the 6<sup>th</sup> subject) even if they are currently taking some subjects at more demanding level (MDL). The school will inform those who are eligible to continue to take these subjects at MDL in Sec 3 separately.
- Students who do very well in G1 subjects, may also be offered to take these subjects at MDL in Sec 3 and will be informed separately.

# PREDOMINANTLY G2 SUBJECTS



## Important things to note

- Students taking predominantly G2 subjects in Secondary 2 will take **6 or 7** subjects when they progress to Secondary 3.

*Note: Students who are officially exempted from Mother Tongue may take 5 – 6 subjects.*

- The 7<sup>th</sup> Subject (G2 Additional Mathematics) is optional.

# PREDOMINANTLY G2 SUBJECTS



## Important things to note

- Students will select their subject combinations using the ALL EARS platform. Students will be given five choices and they are to rank their choices in order of preference (where the first choice is the most preferred combination).
- Students who miss their preferred combination's criteria by a few marks, can still select it as their first choice. However, the four remaining choices **must** be combinations they are eligible for.
- Being eligible for a combination does not guarantee that you will get the combination. It is also dependent on your choice and the vacancies in each subject combination.
- Minimum enrolment to open a class for a specific subject: **15** students.

# PREDOMINANTLY G2 SUBJECTS



## Important things to note

- Students taking predominantly G2 subjects in Secondary 2 will select from Combination B even if they are currently taking some subjects at G3 level. The school will inform those who are eligible to continue to take these subjects at G3 level in Sec 3 separately.
- Students who do very well in some G2 subjects, may also be offered to take these subjects at MDL in Sec 3 and will be informed separately.
- The school will engage both students and parents if we see a need to consider taking certain subjects at less demanding level (LDL).

# PREDOMINANTLY G3 SUBJECTS



## Important things to note

- Students taking predominantly G3 subjects in Sec 2 can take a range of 6 to 8 subjects.

Note:

*Students who are officially exempted from Mother Tongue may take 5 – 7 subjects.*

- Students are advised to select 8 subject combinations **only if they are confident that they can manage the demands for all 8 subjects.**
- Students taking 8 subject combinations will end school later than the rest of the cohort.

# PREDOMINANTLY G3 SUBJECTS



## Important things to note

- Students who are offered G3 Music should consider applying for 6 or 7 subjects in school.
- If your G3 Music lessons clash with your other lessons in school, the music lessons will take precedence.
- Students who sign up for the G3 Music are expected to follow through the programme for 2 years.

- Students who meet the minimum criteria to do pure Sciences, will use the first four choices for Pure Science combinations (D and E). The **5<sup>th</sup>** choice **must** be a Combined Science combination (C). In the event that the Pure Sciences vacancies are filled up, we will know the students' preferred choice for combined Science combinations.
- Minimum enrolment to open a class for a specific subject: **15** students.
